Terms	Description
subscription	Regularly recurring delivery of specified geo- data products.
subscription fee	License fee which is paid for the right to re- ceive automatic updates to geodata products, at certain intervals or upon order.
	Subscription fee can be annual fee, monthly fee or notification fee.
	License fee for customers with a subscription agreement.
	Subscription fee for real property information is also known as a notification fee. For geo- graphic information, the term annual fee is used.
administrative fee	Fee charged for orders of geographic information that require manual handling.
usage category	Division of usage according to geodata opera- tions; public usage, commercial end usage, non-commercial usage (non-profit and private usage, respectively), use for research or educa- tion.
unique visitors per week	Fee for unique visitors per week are only ap- plied to geographical in-formation. Unique vis- itor refers to a web browser at a domain address or website. The fee is paid for each unique visi- tor at the domain address or website, regardless of the type of information that the visitor re-

	quests or uses. This means that visitors do not need to open a map or image, or make a search query to count as a unique visitor.
notification	Regularly recurring delivery of updated data. Upon notification, changed objects are deliv- ered in the agreed geodata product.
notification fee	Subscription fee to automatically and at certain intervals receive monitoring of changes in geo- data products.
direct access service	Basic service for selection and access to data from one or more data sets.
distribution	The provision of geodata in unprocessed or processed form, including grants of rights (li- cence) for the use of geodata or for the use of a product/service including geodata.
personal use	Individual, private use.
one-time fee	License fee which is paid at a single point and confers and unlimited right of use for the pe- riod in question. License fee for customers with a one-time withdrawal agreement.
external use	End customer conditions that allow sharing with or publication/disclosure for a party other than the legal or natural person who holds the license agreement for usage.
fixed fee	Fee which does not change, for example as a result of changes to geo-graphical area or number. Fixed fees can be charged at a single point, annually or at other intervals.
basic real property in- formation	Real property-related information in accord- ance with the Real Property Register Act (2000:224) and information in registers that are maintained in accordance with the Ordinance on maintaining a register of joint property man- agement associations (1993:1270) and the Mortgage Certificates Register Act (1994:448).

research, education and cultural activities	End usage within operations that are concerned with education and non-commercial research, as well as cultural and library activities.
derivative product	Product made by processors that contain, or whose production is dependent on, Lantmäteriet's geodata.
contractor's commit- ment	Agreement regulating the licensee's right to temporarily share their license with consultants, contractors etc., for a very specific task.
geodata	Comprehensive term referring to data that de- scribes features, including their geographical location. Geodata includes both data with geo- graphic information and property information. Geodata is collected in or accessible through various compilations, works, databases, cata- logs, products, services, maps, etc.
geodata product	Selection of Lantmäteriet's reference data that has been copied, possibly processed and deliv- ered according to a standardised specification.
	Product that is packaged to provide Land Surveying's geodata.
	Packaging can be product type or compilation of all or parts of one or more data sets (all or parts can be included).
	Provided via an IT-based service (basic service or e-service).
geodata service	Digital basic service with a machine-to-ma- chine interface that allows access and handled geodata.
basic geographic infor- mation	Information about features or phenomenon that are connected to a position in relation to the earth's surface.
base fee	Fee according to LMFS. The base fee is used to calculate the license fee. Fee for geodata prod- uct before any discounts or mark-ups.

reference data	Term information concerning real property, to- pography, images and geodesics that Lantmäteriet as a government agency is charged with managing and coordinating.
non-commercial use	End use which refers to use for the use of geo- data products by non-profit organisations and individual persons for their own, non-commer- cial purposes.
internal use	End use that allows use within a company, or- ganisation or private use.
commercial end-cus- tomer use	End use which refers to use within operations run for commercial purposes in various forms of association (joint-stock company, limited partnership, general partnership, partnership firm, co-operative association, European economic interest grouping, certain foundations etc.).
delivery format	Format in which a geodata product is provided.
license fee	Calculated fee which licensees must pay to be authorised to use Lantmäteriet's geodata prod- ucts. A license fee is charged for all types of use where geodata/geodata products are in- cluded (except for geodata products that are open data).
license agreement	Agreement which regulates the parties' provi- sion/use of geodata products. License agree- ments can be established with commercial pro- cessors or end customers. License agreements with end customers are also known as end cus- tomer agreements.
license provider	Lantmäteriet or party representing Lantmäteriet.
licensee	The party that has acquired rights concerning geodata products through a license agreement with Lantmäteriet or party representing Lantmäteriet. The rights may include the right to provide geodata products to end customers,

	the right to produce derivative products that contain Lantmäteriet's geodata products, or the right to use geodata products for internal, pri- vate use.
licensing terms and conditions	Terms and conditions for the licensee's use of geodata products.
LMFS	Lantmäteriet's provisions regarding fees for basic geographical information and real property information – Geodata – as well as geodesics and mortgage bonds.
machine-to-machine	Interface/contact point between systems. Also called application interface, i.e. interface that programs use to consume a service.
machine-to-human	Interact/contact point which can be used di- rectly by a person. This includes graphical user interfaces.
download service	Basic service which enables downloading and, when possible, direct access to copies of geo- data products or parts of geodata products.
public sector use	End use for the carrying out of public tasks, as- suming that they cannot be described as busi- ness operations that take place on a competitive market.
partner	Commercial Further Processor who has entered into a partner agreement with Lantmäteriet. A partner has the right to sign agreements con- cerning Lantmäteriet's geodata with another Commercial Further Processor (VF2) on behalf of Lantmäteriet.
personal data	Personal data means any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person. An identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier. This can, for exam- ple, be information about a person's name and social security number (direct) or about a real

	property designation, a centroid with unique id, co-ordinates and mortgages (indirect).
private use	The use of geodata products by non-profit organisations and individual persons for their own, non-commercial purposes.
s end use	End use means the use of unprocessed or pro- cessed geodata for internal use/own use, i.e. in the ordinary measures that are part of the inter- nal administration or operation of the end cus- tomer's business or organization.
end customer	User who, through a license agreement with Lantmäteriet or party representing Lantmäteriet, acquires the right to use unpro- cessed or processed geodata for internal or pri- vate use.
end customer agree- ment	Agreement which regulates the end customer's use of geodata products.
end customer terms and conditions	End customer terms and conditions for public sector use, commercial end customer use, non- commercial use, and research and education.
initial fee	Fixed fee which is charged when delivering ge- odata products and in connection with handling of consent.
technical description	Description of a geodata product's interface and functionality.
Term catalogue	Document containing descriptions of the deliv- ery format in the real property register or real property price register, with object models and terms.
transaction fee	Fee for queries or answers to queries in a ser- vice, application or system containing geodata. License fee for customers with a geodata ser- vice agreement. Fee for asked question or re- ceived answer to asked question against geo- data service.

third party	Third party refers to an external party which does not match the definition of a contractor.
contractor	A consultant, contractor or other person who carries out a task limited in time and scope, for example development of an application, on be- half of the licensee.
commercial further pro- cessor (VF)	A natural person or a legal body who, through a license agreement for Commercial Further Processing with Lantmäteriet, has acquired one or several rights concerning processing and distribution of geodata.
VF2	Commercial Further Processor who, through a partner, acquired one or several rights to pro- duce derived products containing Lantmäteriet's geodata and to distribute them
viewing service	Basic service which allows users to acquire background images or documents for viewing in the customer's system or applications, for ex- ample through WMS queries.
annual fee	License fee that is paid annually and in ad- vance. The annual fee is paid as long as the ser- vice is in use. The fee grants right to use the service and receive updates.
access right	The way in which a geodata product becomes accessible to users.
purpose of evaluation	Testing that Lantmäteriet is obliged to do be- fore delivery can take place of geodata products that contain personal data. The examination is carried out with the support of the Property Register Act (2000:224) and in some cases ex- amination according to the Apartment Register Act.
	The evaluation required for provision of per- sonal information from the real property regis- ter in accordance with the Real Property Regis- ter Act (2000:224) and the regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European parliament and of the
